Koolhaas pointed out that park requires flexibility that can constantly change and adjust (921). In other words, park should be able to adapt to new social trends and users. This means the park should not be designed for specific program only but it should rather be an open space with full of potential that can turn into any space completely depend on users. Instead of passively occupying, observing, and enjoying provided landscape and spaces, people complete the park by actively participating in activities.

Geumnarae Central Park, located in the middle of concrete apartments, functions as activated landscape and urban platform where series of programs will occur.

Required programs for this park are a large lawn area for various events and activities and plaza where people can enjoy landscape scenery and rest. Also, future construction of Seo-Seoul Museum of Art needed to be in consideration.

This park will be constantly evolving by adopting new innovative design works. Landscape would change its color througout the seasons in combination of different art works as objects, this park will generate different scene every year and every season and will not be the same at any time.
